Three Questions | Discussion Notes

In this session we've got a chance to dig into the passage from Acts as well as talking practically about baptism. We're based around the first session from our Baptism Preparation course on metromentoring.org, so [watch this first session together here](#).^{*} When Philip says, "read the passages together" we can stop to study Acts 8:26-40 together.

- What stands out to you about the passage?
- What can we learn about how we can share faith with our friends from this passage?
- Who do you feel more like in this passage - Philip or the eunuch?
- What can we learn about baptism from the story?
- What does verse 39 tell us about what finding Jesus and sharing our faith should look like?

Now get back to the rest of the video and we'll chat about what Philip teaches us.

- Philip says that baptism is a command for Jesus for his followers, not a suggestion. Do you agree? Does that surprise you?
- If you have been baptised, what do you remember of that day?
- Why do you think baptism is so important?
- Philip shared that there can be some things that get in the way of us being baptised, but in the story in Acts the eunuch says "what's to stop my being baptised?" So what does stop us being baptised?
