

DEALING WITH **DOUBT**

Part 2. THE DARK NIGHT

Take some time to discuss Martin's interview. If any of your Hub members were not around on Sunday remember to give a trigger warning, before you fill them in on what was talked about (or you could watch the first 5 mins of the talk where Philip gives a warning and fills us in with the details of the story).

It is likely that people will have lots of thoughts and reflections, so feel free to just open up the floor for people to share, but if you need a few questions to help get you going or guide the discussion here are a few that might be helpful:

- What struck you most about what Martin shared?
- Did you relate to the story of the fabric warehouse or the word that Lex shared, about being embarrassed to bring God our messy lives? How can we combat this and come to God without shame?
- How can we build a faith that can withstand this kind of trauma? Are we investing in our relationship with God in the good times so we can draw strength from it in the bad?
- How can we build Hub and church as a place that can support people when the storms of life hit?

Take some time to pray together, that you would each know God deeper and more personally and that we would be able to come to him with whatever we are carrying at the moment.

If people feel comfortable to, you could ask people to share what they are carrying at the moment and pray into that for each other.
