Read John 2 v 1 – 12

- A lot of Jesus' ministry that is recorded in the gospels is done round a dinner table, with food and drink. What significance does this hold for you?
- And what difference would it make if most of Jesus' ministry instead was done in the temple?
- Why do you think that God chose this as Jesus' first miracle? What does this communicate to you?
- Mary and Jesus' relationship was very close and intimate. It was from this place that she asked him to act on behalf of the bride & groom. How does it change the way we pray when we ask from a place of deep relationship vs. a place of distance?
- What could we do as a hub this week to increase our trust in Jesus?
- Only the servants knew about the miracle. Why do you think he chose to do it this way?
- Jesus produced around 1,000 bottles of wine for the wedding couple. He provided extravagantly for them. Have you ever had an experience where Jesus provided extravagantly for you?
- How easy/difficult do you find it get your head around the idea of God's extravagant grace towards us? Especially on the cross.

Take some time to pray to finish.

Secondly, take some time to pray that we would each grow in our trust of Jesus' and our knowledge of his extravagant grace.
